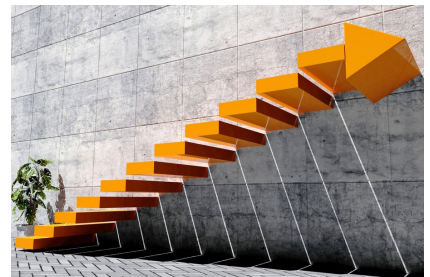
Resource: *Aligning the Registered Apprenticeship and Workforce Development Systems*
