Featured Tool: Frameworks for Building Competency-Based Apprenticeship Programs



The Urban Institute has compiled 43 [competency-based occupational frameworks for Registered Apprenticeships](#) in diverse industries that include advanced manufacturing, business services, education, energy, finance/insurance, healthcare, hospitality, information technology, and transportation. Apprenticeship professionals can review specific frameworks with potential sponsors to help them develop high-quality Registered Apprenticeship Programs that emphasize skills attainment rather than hours accrued. Available occupations include wind turbine technician, cybersecurity support technician, general insurance associate, community health worker, and more. These frameworks have been vetted by industry leaders and are free to use.

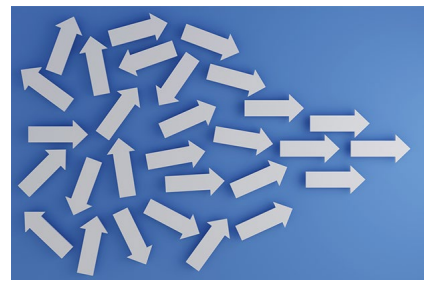
Featured Resource: National Library of Healthcare Registered Apprenticeships



The [Healthcare Career Advancement Program](#) (H-CAP) has created the [National Library of Healthcare Apprenticeships](#), a clearinghouse of over 114 apprenticeship programs in healthcare occupations that both State Apprenticeship Agency and Office of Apprenticeship states can utilize. The demand for healthcare apprenticeships continues to grow, and this clearinghouse provides real-world examples of existing programs including on-the-job learning outlines, classroom instruction outlines, and other information. Apprenticeship professionals can utilize this information to work with healthcare partners to review, select, and adapt the occupational outlines and competency models to their apprenticeship efforts.
