The number of women entering apprenticeship is steadily increasing. But there is more work to do to combat women's underrepresentation in high-wage careers, both in Registered Apprenticeship and in the general workforce. Quality preapprenticeship programs provide essential support for women to help them enter and succeed in Registered Apprenticeship Programs that lead to well-paid, sustainable careers. Pre-Apprenticeship: Pathways for Women into High-Wage Careers from the U.S. Department of Labor is a guide for workforce and community-based programs on developing and implementing preapprenticeship programs that create opportunities for women.
